After download [http://www.kernel.org/pub/linux/kernel/v2.6/linux-2.6.18.tar .bz2](http://www.kernel.org/pub/linux/kernel/v2.6/linux-2.6.18.tar.bz2) kernel, patch this [http://download.openvz.org/kernel/devel/028test010.1/patches /patch-ovz028test010.1-combined.gz](http://download.openvz.org/kernel/devel/028test010.1/patches/patch-ovz028test010.1-combined.gz) and <http://www.spinics.net/lists/sparclinux/msg00681.html>,

make-kpkg, install header and image, reboot,

woo, no kernel panic, great.  
but it showed mount error:

```
