Hi Jim,

vzpkgls and vzpkgcache located in tool "vzpkg" (sources and rpm can be downloaded at <http://download.openvz.org/template/utls/> )

They are used (Virtuozzo \*and\* OpenVZ)to build precreate rpm - based OS-Templates (but on Virtuozzo deb-Packages are converted to a rpm-like Virtuozzo structure !) out of some "Metadata" file.

On Debian Sarge (aka. stable) its useless, due some dependencies to yum, rpm and some libs.
