like this:

```

# ethernet interface
```

auto eth0
```

```
iface eth0 inet static
```

```
address 11.22.33.152
```

```
network 11.22.33.0
```

```
netmask 255.255.255.0
```

```
broadcast 11.22.33.255
```

```
gateway 11.22.33.1
```

```
# virtual interfaces
```

```
auto eth0:1
```

```
iface eth0:1 inet static
```

```
address 11.22.33.172
```
