Hi, I created a new VE today, and was configuring it and all was going well until I restarted it and I am now unable to either enter it with:

```
vzctl enter 107
```

Or ssh into the VE.

When I try to enter the VE I get this error.

```
Enter into VE 107 failed
```

```
Unable to open pty: No such file or directory
```

When I try to ssh into the VE I get this error:

```
ssh: connect to host academic.umfk.maine.edu port 22: Connection refused
```

I found the bug in bugzilla with someone with a similar issue with Ubuntu.

with the latest kernels, etc...

In Bugzilla it says the issue has to do with showconsole, but I searched the /etc/ directory for showconsole and did not find any init scripts with a reference to showconsole.

Everything else on the VE seems to be running just fine, but I need to get access to it.

And this did not allow me to access it.

The problem seemed to arise after I configured winbind and smb to start on

Does anyone know how to fix this problem.
