Well I installed the Etch AMD64 version from a daily netinst ROM and also a pre-built AMD64 OpenVZ kernel. A few things I noticed:

I can now create and run VPSes created from an AMD64 bit template.

The VZCpucheck application showed a decrease in "CPU power" from then I was running the ordinary Etch but with the kernel built for a flat memory space.

The OpenVZ tools were installed from [systs.org](#) and may be 32 bit.

Does anyone know if the result from `vzcpucheck` is meaningful in comparison to the same hardware with a 32bit etch?

Also, are there any benefits to running with a 64bit OS?
