I am having issues with vzyum on my x86_64 Dell SC430 server as well.

Getting this:

```
exec /usr/share/vzyum/bin/yum -c /vz/template/fedora-core/5/i386/config/yum.conf --installroot  
/vz/root/101 --vps=101 update
```

There was a problem importing one of the Python modules
required to run yum. The error leading to this problem was:

```
/usr/share/vzpkgtools/vzrpm44/lib/python2.3/site-packages/rp m/_rpmmodule.so: cannot open  
shared object file: No such file or directory
```

It seems this is a known issue and there is no solution for it?

Running 'yum' from the VE is difficult because the 'update' process consumes a lot of
disk/memory. I am getting disk space and memory errors when try the yum update from the VE.
