How will this affect current RH 4 systems running OpenVZ. Will we simply be able to install the new kernel while keeping all of the rest of the system at the RH 4 level?

Or will we need to install RH 5 and use the Openvz kernel based off of RH 5 to keep our systems up to date with the stable kernel branch?
