Generally speaking, vzctl takes care of it — it sends ARP packets, sets up routing etc. The only things you have to check are:

- 1. IP forwarding is enabled on the host system
- 2. IP addresses used for VEs are from the same subnet as the IP of the host system, OR if they are from the different subnet, other systems should have a route to that subnet with the gateway being host system IP.
