You have to install SMP kernel.
but it would be more correct comparison if SMP kernel is used.

according to boot log, kernel found the device, detected link, but DHCP client failed to get IP address.

Do you have an access to the machine when it is booted to OVZ kernel? If yes, please do some actions:

```
# ip a l  
# /etc/init.d/network restart
```
