2.6.16 ovz kernel is no longer supported. It contains checkpointing modules, but this kernel is not stable as it was not updated for a long time.

So, I would suggest you to use more recent and stable 2.6.18 kernel.

Hi,

OK, I understand that my kernel is no longer supported, however I don't see anything newer than 2.16 for FC. Are you suggesting I change distros entirely or do you know of a 2.18 FC kernel somewhere?
