Hello,

ACPI\_SLEEP is enabled there it's possible in OpenVZ configs. Look, for example at  
[http://download.openvz.org/kernel/branches/2.6.18/current/co\\_nfigs/kernel-2.6.18-i686.config.ovz](http://download.openvz.org/kernel/branches/2.6.18/current/co_nfigs/kernel-2.6.18-i686.config.ovz) -  
ACPI\_SLEEP is enabled, but there is no ACPI\_SLEEP in  
[http://download.openvz.org/kernel/branches/2.6.18/current/co\\_nfigs/kernel-2.6.18-i686-smp.config.ovz](http://download.openvz.org/kernel/branches/2.6.18/current/co_nfigs/kernel-2.6.18-i686-smp.config.ovz)

The thing is that ACPI\_SLEEP depends on (X86 && (!SMP || SUSPEND\_SMP)). So,  
ACPI\_SLEEP is only possible on x86 architectures with UP.
