Hello,

ACPI_SLEEP is enabled there it's possible in OpenVZ configs. Look, for example at <http://download.openvz.org/kernel/branches/2.6.18/current/configs/kernel-2.6.18-i686.config.ovz> - ACPI_SLEEP is enabled, but there is no ACPI_SLEEP in <http://download.openvz.org/kernel/branches/2.6.18/current/configs/kernel-2.6.18-i686-smp.config.ovz>

The thing is that ACPI_SLEEP depends on (X86 && (!SMP || SUSPEND_SMP)). So, ACPI_SLEEP is only possible on x86 architectures with UP.
