Hi All...

I have a SuperMicro system running OpenVZ on Debian Etch AMD64. It has 2 ethernet ports on the system board. Recently, I added a PCI-X dual port Ethernet card. I was unable to make these two ports talk to the network and also, this addition caused the VPSes to be unable to talk to the LAN. I deconfigured the new ports in /etc/network/interfaces and fixed it after a reboot.

Is there any reason OpenVZ would have caused this? I can't seem to find an alternative cause but I can't see why OpenVZ would do it either.
