If you have only one or two VPSs, you can use real devices dedicated to each VPS, but this is not your case. For now, we don't work on Ethernet level and you are required to have one more real IP for the block.

I suppose, that from security point of view it is a not big deal, while you can use netfilter to protect it and additionally all VPSs, because their traffic goes through HN route tables.

If it is still the problem, you can check Virtuozzo's Name Based Hosting feature - it allows to use one real IP for multiple VPSs (pop, smtp, http, ftp)
