Hello, there is no such tool in OpenVZ. In Virtuozzo special filesystem type (vzfs) is used, that performs this action: it greatly saves the amount of disk space.

However you can do it manually in OpenVZ as it usually done on LiveCDs. You probably know unionfs is used in LiveCDs. So you can create one read-only VE and then mount it to the private areas of each real VEs as a read-only branch of uninfs. You get the same result. But in order to do it automatically on VE start/stop you'll have to dig in vzctl
