I did what you recommended and the only value in the "failcnt" column that appears to have changed during the tests was the "numproc".

but here is the low down:

Test 1: prior to start websphere I ran "cat /proc/user_beancounters" and saved it to a file:
user_beancounters_prerun

Test 2: during the websphere startup I ran the command again: user_beancounters_duringrun

Test 3: a few minutes into the startup process I ran the command again:
user_beancounters_duringpostrun

Test 4: after "ctrl +c" in the terminal windows that started websphere I ran the command again:
user_beancounters_duringpostrun2

I don't see anything glaring... perhaps I am missing something?
