I did what you recommended and the only value in the "failcnt" column that appears to have changed during the tests was the "numproc".

See attachments for more details...

but here is the low down:

Test 1: prior to start websphere I ran "cat /proc/user\_beancounters" and saved it to a file:  
`user_beancounters_prerun`

Test 2: during the websphere startup I ran the command again: `user_beancounters_duringrun`

Test 3: a few minutes into the startup process I ran the command again:  
`user_beancounters_duringpostrun`

Test 4: after "ctrl +c" in the terminal windows that started websphere I ran the command again:  
`user_beancounters_duringpostrun2`

I don't see anything glaring... perhaps I am missing something?
