Yum doesn't know anything special about the kernels (aside from the fact they should be installed, not upgraded; also some yum setups care to deinstall very old kernel packages). So it's up to the user to decide which kernel to use. I have just checked installation instructions on wiki ( http://wiki.openvz.org/Quick\_installation#Kernel\_installation) and they clearly tell a user to select the proper kernel, see:

Using yum

Run the following command

# yum install ovzkernel[-flavor]
