Hello,

- 1) `--devices b:3:0:r --save` does not create a device node in /dev. It only grants permissions to the device! You can use `--devnodes hda:r --save` command, which not only grants permissions, but aslo creates a node.
- 2) However, if you're using udev in VE (just check whether tmpfs is mounted on /dev, if it is so, then you're using udev), you need to create a device node inside VE manually once again: vzctl exec <veid> mknod /dev/hda b 3 0 HTH, Vasily.
