- > start/stop test -- the idea is to have many VEs starting and stopping in
- > parallel -- trying to catch some locking bugs etc. Unfortunately we do
- > not have any tests open sourced, but we will definitely want to help
- > testing as well.

I did some Kernel System Call Tests of the LTP-20070430 (http://ltp.sourceforge.net) inside a VE. 20 Tests failed but more then 700 passed. Most of the failed ones had to do with Swap space and Setting time. This is unavailable inside a VE, right?
