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Hi all,

as I mentioned already yesterday I get this error when I try to start the OpenVZ service:

I tried the latest kernels 2.6.18 and 2.6.20 with CONFIG_SCHED_VCPU=y and CONFIG_FAIRSCHEDE=y
For both kernels the vzctl command ends up with the same error.

Can someone explain me why it is searching for a file or directory? Is fairsched_chwt a device?
