Hello,

Thank you for your post, it's very important for us to see that people use OpenVZ LiveCD.

About disk space. As you now LiveCD is based on tmpfs, so all VE's files are in memory.

Unfortunately at the moment vzquota doesn't support tmpfs:

This is why you see zeroes in df output. A workaround for it is to disable vzquota on OpenVZ LiveCD in /etc/vz/vz.conf:

```
[vass@white ~]$ cat /etc/vz/vz.conf | grep DISK_QUOTA
```

```
DISK_QUOTA=yes # << change to "no:
```

Then you'll be able to see the disk space of HN from VE. On usual OpenVZ installation (not LiveCD) it leads to the disadvantage: VE can use any amount of disk space. But on LiveCD OVZ disk quota doesn't work => so no disadvantages.
