Hmmzz .. So he sets "CONFIG_VZ_QUOTA" to be a module instead of including it in the kernel. After that, the VZ device *is* available for module selection.

Since I'm waiting for my kernel to compile, I can explain why I was somewhat staggered seeing that a working config had "CONFIG_VZ_QUOTA=m". The Howto I followed up (http://wiki.openvz.org/Installation_on_Debian#or_build_your_own_kernel-image_.28debian_way.29) said CONFIG_VZ_QUOTA should be included in the kernel .. is this a fault in the howto?
