I have long experience with vmware, and to me directly modifying a VE's "private space" is a no-no -- kind of an "isolation violation." It's kinda like reading someone else's email when you're root. Yes we **can** do it, but **should** we...

I'd much rather prefer private disks per-VE, for \$security. Only root will have direct VE-modify access anyhow, and the procedure I'm thinking of implementing would be available over the Internet for potential customers. (Just leave the VE running, and listening, and \$client can send the tarball over the net whenever.)
