I have built the newest kernel from git to fix this issue.

I am using ubuntu feisty, making packages with:

```
~/openvz/linux-2.6.18-openvz-033-b$ make-kpkg -initrd linux_image linux_headers --rootcmd  
fakeroot
```

Trying to boot new kernel, I'm getting boot error:

```
init_premount / udev 21
```

```
cannot create /proc/sys/kernel/hotplug ... operation not permitted
```

After some time, I am getting boot prompt
(initramfs)

and message:

```
cannot find: /dev/mapper/Ubuntu-root
```

System obviously cannot find my SATA disk and LVM volumes.

I have used the same procedure and same .config to build kernel packages stable033 and stable031, and I had no problems.
