I had the same problem:

ahuxley@pc012939\$ ssh root@loofah pwd ahuxley@pc012939\$

After the posting of a very cut-down /etc/ssh/sshd\_config above, I started stripping stuff out of the full version in order to see what the problem was. And amazingly, it was the 'AcceptEnv' statements!

So fix #1 on the ssh client:

ahuxley@pc012939\$ unset LC\_ALL ahuxley@pc012939\$

or, alternatively, fix #2 on the ssh server:

[root@loofah ssh]# perl -pi -e 's/^(AcceptEnv)/#\$1/' /etc/ssh/sshd\_config

[root@loofah ssh]# /etc/init.d/sshd restart

Stopping sshd: [ OK ] Starting sshd: [ OK ]

[root@loofah ssh]#

I suspect that the "right" fix is to set up the locales correctly on the server. I imagine (but didn't check) that the stripped down FC6 template is missing some of this.
