Sorry! When I was reading your message first time, I thought, that you're using 028stab031 kernel. So I look through the fixes, that were applied since 028stab031 and haven't found anything fixing othersockbuf. Consequently I assumed that it is a new bug.
But now I understand, that you're using Debian OpenVZ kernel based on 028test018. It is pretty old kernel and there were pretty much fixes since it.
So, can you, please, update your system till the latest kernel (028stab035). Compile the new kernel by yourself or use precompiled kernel from debian.systems.org.
Also we're going to release the fresh patch against Debian kernel soon.
I close the bug http://bugzilla.openvz.org/show_bug.cgi?id=619, that you have reported, as fixed.
If the problem will arise again on latest kernel - feel free to reopen it.
