I guess I was not clear enough.

I have a liveCD of a PBX appliance running fedora 7.

I need to run this inside a VE.

Std procedure would be

1. Create a VE with fedora 7 template
2. Enter the VE
3. Install the application RPMs

The problem is that the install procedure is broken, so just installing the RPMs is not installing the application correctly.

So I trying to see if I can create a template from the liveCD of the appliance. Along with the OS Metadata, I am trying to copy all the major directories so that the appliance's metadata is also copied along with the OS metadata.

So the steps would be

1. Extract OS metadata
2. Extract appliance metadata
3. create template from the metadata extracted from the above 2 steps.

Please note that this procedure is needed only because the install procedure of the PBX appliance is broken.
