The typical configuration of secured OVZ looks the following way:

HN	VEs
-----	-----
eth0 (assigned local IP address)	
eth1 (assigned global IP address)	VEs are routed
and set as default default GW	through eth1, since
	it's default GW.

the only difference is that eth1 still has global IP assigned to HN. But this is a plus on the other hand, since HN often needs an access to internet for example for upgrades.

In this case you simple need to put "eth1" to /etc/vz/conf variable:

17 # The name of the device whose ip address will be used as source ip for VE.

18 # By default automatically assigned.

19 #VE_ROUTE_SRC_DEV="eth1"
