mercury:~# /sbin/ip rule add from 87.98.196.137 table 10
```

```
mercury:~# /sbin/ip route add default dev eth0 via 87.98.196.129 table 10
```

RTNETLINK answers: Network is unreachable
```

mercury:~#
```

This simply means that Hardware Node does not know how to get to 87.98.196.129. Could you please try again with:

```
# ip route add 87.98.196.128/26 dev eth0
```

```
# ip rule add from 87.98.196.137 table 10
```

```
# ip route add default dev eth0 via 87.98.196.129 table 10
```

This should eliminate the "Network is unreachable" error.
