I don't see how the script is different from crond's:

(stop parts only)

```
Puppet:stop() {
    echo -n "Stopping puppet: "
    killproc $puppetd
    RETVAL=$?
    echo
    [ $RETVAL = 0 ] && rm -f ${lockfile} ${pidfile}
}
```

```
Crond:stop() {
    echo -n "Stopping $prog: "
    if [ ! -e /var/lock/subsys/crond ]; then
        echo -n "$cannot stop crond: crond is not running."
        failure "$cannot stop crond: crond is not running."
        echo
        return 1;
    fi
    killproc crond
    RETVAL=$?
    echo
    [ $RETVAL -eq 0 ] && rm -f /var/lock/subsys/crond;
    return $RETVAL
}
```

I'd gladly submit this to the puppet's developers, but I can't see how the behaviour is different.
