or add to apt/sources.list:

deb <http://debian.systs.org/> etch opensvz

Btw, this linux-kernel is outdated, it's a build with OpenVZ patch 028test018.1, the new stable kernels are build with patch 028stab035.1.

On debian repro at debian.systs.org linux-image builded with official OpenVZ kernel-config are avail, too.
