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Well Nevermind, it worked, and believe you or not, the problem was using the ip command.

DON'T do these steps:

```
virtual 104 #> /sbin/ip addr add 192.168.12.104 dev eth0
```

```
virtual 104 #> /sbin/ip route add default dev eth0
```

Instead of that use simply :

```
virtual 104 #> ifconfig eth0 192.168.12.104
```

```
virtual 104 #> route add default gw 192.168.12.100
```

and remove any thing not needed from the routing table, in my case

```
virtual 104 #> route del default gw 192.0.2.1
```

That is it!!!
