Hi Alexey,

could you please check the following:

1) Could you please confirm that you have used our default config and do not changed any OpenVZ-specific options?

Modprobe can return "Unknown symbol" messages you have compiled kernel without supporting of modules required for the module. But if you have used our default kernel config -- in this case all requires modules should be builded and installed successfully.

2) Could you please check that `/lib/modules/<kernel_version>/modules.dep` file exists?

After installation new kernel on the node you should use "depmod" utility that should create a list of module dependencies

`(/lib/modules/<kernel_version>/modules.dep)`

3) Are you sure that you have prepared correct initrd file for your new kernel? Modules from old initrd will have wrong dependencies if new kernel is loaded.
