Alexey Eremenko wrote on Thu, 26 July 2007 11:30SSH fails (because of lack of /dev/random) it's known issue: udev in OpenSuse10.2 do not created mem-based device files (i.e. random and urandom) because do not find according information in sysfs inside VE.

To work-around this issue you can create random and urandom device files in /lib/udev/devices directory, then they will be created on any VE boot.
