- > I suspect this may be something I can't do in a VE, but I thought I'd
- > ask :-)

You can -- see the 'devices' and 'devnodes' settings in vzctl.

The process is that you grant access to specific devices to a specific VE and, once that is done, the kernel allows them to access the device directly.
