Well I finally succeeded in getting OpenOffice working using vncserver. With regard to the Alfresco product I found a wiki-page ([http://wiki.alfresco.com/wiki/Running\\_OpenOffice\\_From\\_Terminal](http://wiki.alfresco.com/wiki/Running_OpenOffice_From_Terminal)) that described a way to run OpenOffice from a terminal.

What I did was I installed vncserver and started it with display 1, like this:  
# vncserver :1

furthermore I adjusted the startup command of OpenOffice and it came out like this:  
# /opt/Alfresco/openoffice.org2.1/program/soffice "  
-accept=socket,host=localhost,port=8100;urp;StarOffice.ServiceManager " -nologo -headless  
-nofirststartwizard -display :1 &

Because I had to make a lot of steps in getting Alfresco to work on the VPS, I wrote a Howto. Currently it's not more than a quick & dirty note just good enough for me to fall back to if needed, but if anyone is interesting I'm more than happy to rewrite it a bit and put it on the internet.
