The order of VPS filesystem and Virtuozzo Disk Quota under File systems is wrong.

Try to select VPS filesystem if Virtuozzo Disk Quota support is not selected in kernel. You can't because it is not shown.

Now select Virtuozzo Disk Quota support as module. Try to compile VPS filesystem in the kernel (not as module). You can't because Virtuozzo Disk Quota is a module.

Select Virtuozzo Disk Quota support.

Over Virtuozzo Disk Quota support you can find VPS filesystem?!?

This is all tested with menuconfig.

So, maybe the appearance of the options is dissordered or something else is wrong.

Is VPS filesystem support needed for Virtuozzo Disk Quota support? If yes, there is a problem with Kconfig depends
