First, it's preferable to use vzyum for installation of packages inside the VPS, just because that way there will be a common yum cache to be used by all VPSs based on a given OS template. Well, if you plan to have just one CentOS VPS, you can use yum from inside VPS as well.

So the questions are:

1. What your host system rpm and yum versions are? ('rpm -q rpm yum')
 2. Does rpm -q work inside your VPS? What VPS' rpm and yum versions are? ('rpm -q rpm yum' inside VPS).
 3. Try 'yum makecache' inside VPS if your yum version supports it
