mkinitrd creates initrd image -- script that loads the drivers required for mounting root partition. mkinitrd from CentOS4 distribution was tuned for RHEL4 (2.6.9) based kernels, knows nothing about more fresh kernels and therefore can fail on the some nodes.

If you wish to use 2.6.18 kenrels I would recommend you to install CehtOs 5 on HW node and then install RHEL5 based OpenVZ kernels.

ALso I would note that IMHO CentOS5 should support NVidia NIC on your node. And if it works on CentOS 5 kernel -- then it should works on the RHEL5-based OpenVz kernels too.
