Setting user beancounter parameters is an advanced task (described in soon-to-be-released SLM Guide). Basically, all the parameters are inter-dependant and you can not just change one parameter and hope it will work. So you'd better stick to existing config samples, or at least use `vzcfgvalidate` to check your new config for validity.

And yes, `privvmpages` parameter's unit is pages. On ix86 architecture a page is equal to 4096 bytes, or 4 kilobytes.
