I tried to start the vms via hypervm control panel but i get this error?

i have checked /etc/grub.conf and its set to default=0

also if i try to connect to the server via command access in hyper vm i get this error!

Unable to open /dev/vzctl: No such file or directory

Please check that vzdev kernel module is loaded and you have sufficient permissions to access the file.

I recon its a problem with openvz

any ideas please? It was fully working, i had 2 vps servers running one with cpanel and had sites resloved to it and another with centos base install on it? all working perfect. kind regards,
