these values appear very low for your hardware

```
CPULIMIT="400"  
CPUUNITS="1000"
```

(am i correct the limit should not be smaller than the assigned units for an individual VPS?)

vzcpucheck will give you your current HN limit and you will see immediately you need a sane view on your HN capability. run vzsplrit on your HN and split 16 ways then again split 32 ways. compare the output and look at the CPULIMIT values

also from you config it is interesting for you to look at the limits values for:

VMGUARPAGES  
OOMGUARPAGES  
PRIVVMPAGES  
SHMPAGES
```
