the basic conf is an extremely conservative VPS with 24MB RAM and everything tuned down

use the vzsplitt utility to output an 8 way split of your hardware. compare the output of vzsplitt with the conf of your VPS and you will see the problem. experiment with vzsplitt until you find what you need

that was the solution and as Valmont says the way to check what is happening inside the VPS:

```
cat /proc/user_beancounters
```
