> Changes [try #2]
- removed struct user_namespace* argument from find_user()- added a root_user per user namespace
> execns() syscall is back in the attic for the moment. I'm still maintaining > it and we'll see if it's of any use when we address the user space API of > the full conainer. soon, I hope!
> This user namespace patchset does not try to address all the issues that > were raised by the previous thread on the topic, like user mapping per > namespace, per mount, etc. It tries to solve some simple issues with the > current implementation of containers in mind. It should be especially > useful the existing solutions and lay ground basic objects.
