The code to look at tty\_old\_pgrp and send SIGHUP and SIGCONT when it is present only executes when disassociate\_ctty is called from do\_exit. Make this clear by adding an explicit on\_exit check, and explicitly setting tty\_old\_pgrp to 0.

In addition fix the locking by reading tty\_old\_pgrp under the siglock.
