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Hi All:

In looking at OpenVZ, I believe it can support a 2.4 Kernel running as a VPS. But to run a 2.4 kernel, I think we need the following items:

- 1) Source code for the dummy-<os>.swsoft.i386.rpm
(I assume I need to put in a different OS's version)
- 2) Details of what comprises the templates files
(should be able to reverse engineer this, but would be a lot easier with documentation)
- 3) Use of other YUM versions
(older kernels have old yum support. I can figure out how to package it in newer local yum repositories if needed).

Are my (many) assumptions correct? If yes, can we get the source for the dummy* products?
