> I wonder if there are enough of these cases to start doing:

> #define task_tgid_nr(tsk) pid_nr(task_tgid(tsk))
```

There shouldn't be. We should really fix the arguments of `__set_special_pids` to be `struct_pid *`. At which point this ugliness goes away.
