Subject: Huge problem with baselayout-vserver after update...

Hi,

I'm running gentoo with vserver-sources. I updated my baselayout with baselayout-vserver, then etc-updated everything in init.d (actually, I just kept the hostname et domainname in conf.d as they were).

At reboot, the machine crashed with problems of scripts : could not create 'softscripts' and others... immediately after the hardware boot (at the beginning of gentoo loading).

Well, rebooted with a rescue disk, chrooted and unmerged baselayout-vserver to reinstall the former baselayout (not vserver). I etc-updated again, checking each file (18 this time, 21 the first time).

I recompiled the kernel too, with the same config file.

Now, the machine loads okay but stops after starting services with the message 'INIT :no more scripts left for this runlevel' and then hangs... I never get to the prompt, and I can't access /var/log/messages or syslog...

What can I do to get back my configuration ?

I fear emerge -e world (took me three days last time). Nothing else ?

Thanks in advance for your help !
