> as it makes no sense and is a maintenance problem to handle

> signals in kernel threads.

Vetoed. Removing stuff just because it doesn't make sense to you is not acceptable.

Signal handling in reclaimer threads is there in order to allow administrators to deal with the case where the server never comes up again.
